What is the Assignment Saving Lives Bursary Program, and how does it work?

To ensure patients receive the treatment they need during the summer months, Canadian Blood Services is inviting students enrolled in a postsecondary school to become blood donor recruiters.

- To become eligible for bursaries, students are challenged to recruit potential blood donors between May 29th 2017 and September 2nd 2017.
- This Contest is open to all residents of Manitoba, who are 16 years of age or older who:
 - are presently enrolled in a secondary school in Canada or in a post-secondary education program in Canada; and, fully complete, and submit the Canadian Blood Services Contest Registration form on or before July 31, 2017
 - Canadian Blood Services employees and immediate family members are not eligible.
 - For every 25 people registered, one ballot will be entered into a draw for bursaries
- Educational bursaries will be awarded in the Fall.

Why Get Involved?

- Here's a great opportunity to invest in your education by investing in the health of Canadians.
- Only 4% of eligible Canadians donate blood and we need your help to improve that
- In Manitoba we have over 2000 open blood donor appointments that need to be filled over the summer months
